We use a small java application to present the virtual tours in a resized window on your screen. The application that we use is not downloaded to your computer and does not leave any 'cookies' or other files on your computer.

If your workplace has disabled java for security reasons, please consult your IT department or provider for guidance.

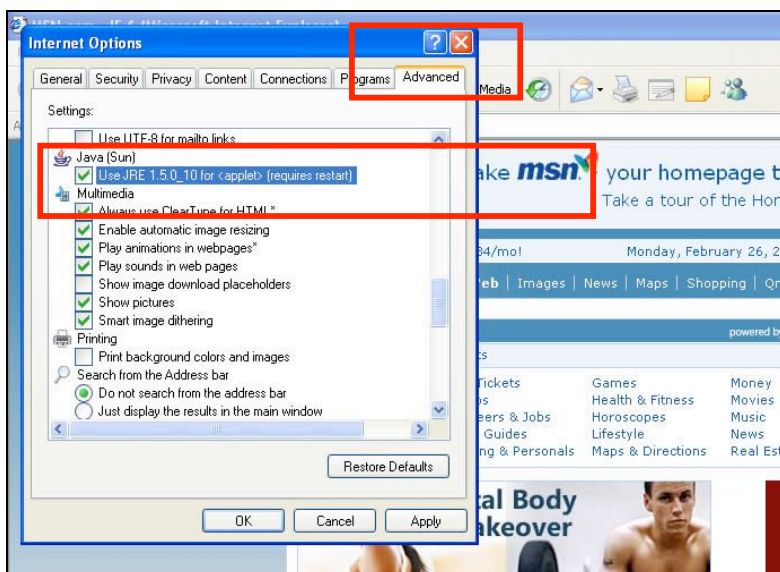
Internet Explorer 6

Select Tools > Internet Options from your browser's menu bar



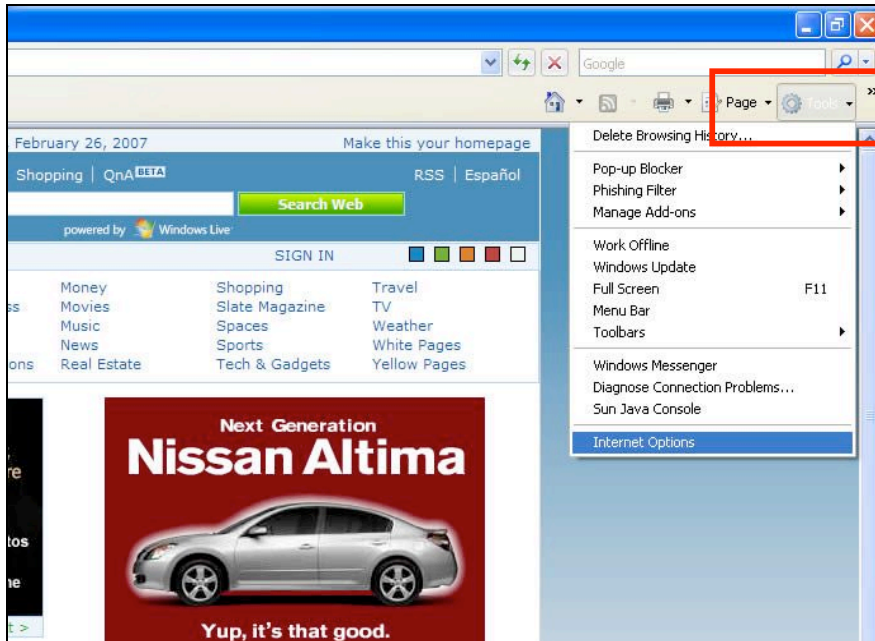
Click on the 'Advanced' tab in Internet Options and scroll down the options until you see "Java (Sun)" and check the box below that label, as shown below.
